

- The NCVO Almanac shows the overall income of Welsh general charities to be £1,258m
- Income earned from individuals is rising. An estimated £521.5m came from individuals in 2016-2017.

POWYS HAS THE MOST CHARITIES PER HEAD

Powys has 16.8 charities per 1,000 people, which is the highest figure of all the local authorities in Wales.

THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN HAS THE LEAST NUMBER OF CHARITIES PER HEAD








HOW MANY PEOPLE VOLUNTEER IN WALES?
