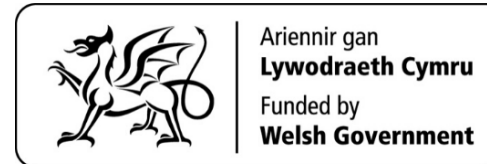

The grant will enable VHTs to carry out extended visiting to their communities. The funding will support and develop the motorbike ambulance service initiated by Care for Uganda with the agreement of Lowero District Health Office(DHO) whilst the management of the service is taken over by the DHO.</p>	£20,000
