As the national membership body for voluntary organisations in Wales, we put our members at the heart of everything we do. From influencing key decision makers to providing expert services, members help to inform our direction.

Connect:

WCVA's ability to connect organisations across Wales through our membership is one of our strengths. Membership connects you with others to share knowledge and spark innovation and ideas.

Events:

As a member organisation, you will have access to a number of member only events each year. These member only events have specific subject themes, and we work with trusted suppliers and guest speakers to deliver expert knowledge and facilitate discussions between our members. These events are the perfect place to share insight, experiences, spark ideas and build relationships for collaboration.

Some of our member only events include workshops during trustees' week, our Annual General Meeting (AGM) and our annual lecture delivered by an exciting and thought-provoking speaker each year.

Relationships:

WCVA members build valuable connections with our staff who play a key role in driving change and championing

the role of the sector in our society. We encourage our members to get in touch via member forums, events, and communication methods to help shape our work.

Ruth Marks, our CEO regularly contributes to inquiries and advisory boards on issues including diversity, equalities, volunteering and the charity sector. Ruth is a trustee of ACEVO and Cynnal Cymru, an advisory board member of Academi Wales as well as a director of the International Federation on Ageing. Ruth takes insight from conversations with our members which in turn informs her extensive work with decision makers.

Membership also connects you with industry leading suppliers who are always keen to learn more about the work of our network. This helps them to shape their products and services to better meet the needs of the voluntary sector in Wales.



Enable:

Membership enables you to reach your full potential as an organisation. WCVA provides sector specific services and advice which makes it easier for organisations to succeed.

Members receive 20% discount on WCVA training (10% discount for our partners). Our training courses are designed with the needs identified by our members and the wider sector in mind and have on average 95% of attendees rate our training as good or excellent. Communications:

Membership provides you with access to a members only area of the WCVA website which allows you to create a personalised bank of resources. Once you are logged in, you can browse our site and favourite blogs and guidance so that they are easily accessible when you need them.

The members area also hosts exclusive communications such as guest blogs from expert trusted suppliers and other members. Information and registration for member only events are also available within the members area.

Influence:

Policy:

Our members help shape our work by taking part in member only forums and voting for WCVA board members and Third Sector Partnership Council elections. Member only forums are used to gather key insight into the big challenges for organisations working in the voluntary sector in Wales.
